Dear Members of the City Planning Commission:

I am writing on behalf of the Mid-City Neighborhood Organization to express our opposition to this matter. The request is vague and overly broad. As phrased in the current application, this proposal could have a significant effect on undermining the intent of the existing ICUC zoning for Tulane Avenue to create a more pedestrian-friendly, human scale environment.

The signs that would be allowed if this proposal were to be passed are precisely the type of highway-oriented signs that are out of scale with the built environment of this urban corridor.

It is not clear what the applicant means by "adjacent to" I-10. It is also not clear why the entire text amendment needs to be amended to accommodate this individual business's request.

MCNO opposes the request.
